MODIFICATION INSTRUCTIONS:

The following instructions in step-by-step format are written as a guide to perform this modification. Compliance with safe maintenance practices as recommended in the Maintenance Manual and FAA regulations is mandatory. Please read all instructions and review all diagrams before starting this modification.

- A. Prepare aircraft for safe maintenance as follows:
 - A-1 Ensure all cockpit switches are off.
 - A-2 Ensure aircraft is grounded and battery is disconnected.
 - A-3 Observe all common aircraft maintenance safety practices.

- B. Replace oil cooler as follows:
 - B-1 Remove the left hand rear baffle from the aircraft. Refer to Maintenance Manual, Chapter 71-6-2.
 - B-2 Remove oil cooler from the aircraft. Refer to Maintenance Manual, Chapter 79-0.
 - B-3 Install new left hand rear baffle assy. Refer to Maintenance Manual, Chapter 71-6-2. The lower inboard mounting screw must be in place before the baffle can be installed.
 - B-4 Install new large oil cooler. Refer to Maintenance Manual, Chapter 79-0.
- C. Return aircraft to flight status.
- D. Record modification in the aircraft logbook.
