Subject: 1974 Model Changes

The following outlines the model changes effective on 1974 model production.

1974 Trainer and TR-2 (AA-1B) Model Changes

- 1. Improved Canopy
 - a. New front.
 - b. Inside/outside canopy latch.
 - c. Bonded windshield and canopy bows.
- 2. New Interior
 - a. New re-styled bucket seats and matching interiors -- provides more head and leg room.
- 3. New Exterior
 - a. The Trainer exterior will be a two-color -- more luxurious.
 - b. The TR-2 exterior will be the same as 1973, due to popular demand, with two exciting optional choices, red or blue on white.
 - d. Urethane paint will be standard.
- 4. New Systems
 - a. New electrical switches and re-spacing of the same to provide for strobe switch option. The switches have "on-off" lettering on the switch.
 - b. An audio amp circuit breaker has been added to the panel.
 - c. Two more circuit breakers have been added for multiple avionics installation.
 - d. The hourmeter fuse and electrical clock fuse have been removed from the panel and installed in a special bracket on the battery support in the engine compartment.
 - e. The GAAC switch panel has been deleted for multiple avionics.
 - f. A switch has been added to the marker beacon lights. The marker beacon installation thus requires no switch panel.

- g. New self-aligning control shaft bearing which eliminates side play and improves service life.
- h. New dual defrosters will be optional in 1974.

1974 Traveler AA-5 Model Changes

- l. New Interior
 - a. New front and rear seats for improved appearance. The front seats are higher and wider. The back seats combine the head rests and back into one removable unit.
 - b. New side panel die-electric patterns.
 - c. Standard vinyl/fabric interior.
 - d. Optional all vinyl interior.
 - e. Baggage compartment is extended six inches aft for more baggage space.
 - f. The upper portion of aft baggage features a hat shelf for more space.
 - g. Rear shoulder harness attachment has been moved aft six inches.
- 2. New Exterior
 - a. The exterior styling of the Traveler is to be a three-color scheme featuring a base color with two-color accent stripe.
 - b. The aft side window has been extended ten inches aft to portray a longer cabin and to increase visibility.
 - c. A re-styled dorsal fin.
 - d. A baggage door will be added to the left side of the fuselage to permit easy access to the baggage area.
 - e. Urethane paint will be standard.
- 3. New Systems
 - a. The instrument panel changes, including the control shaft bearing, are the same as the AA-1B.
 - b. An oil access door (similar to the AA-1B) will be offered as an option.

The following details the design improvements made during 1973 that are now incorporated as standard equipment on the 1974 Grumman American Aircraft.

1974 Trainer (AA-1B) Design Improvements

- 1. Rear window increased thickness.
- 2. Electric Clock replaced mechanical spring type.
- 3. Larger pulleys on control systems to improve cable life.
- 4. Headliner material change.
- 5. Engine cooling improvements.
- 6. Exterior placards Improve toughness.
- 7. Improved access to carburetor airbox filter screws.
- 8. New carburetor fitting to eliminate fuel seepage
- 9. Relocated identification plate from floorboard to aft fuselage.
- 10. Cabin vent box improvements to eliminate leakage.
- 11. Improved vacuum system with differential gage.
- 12. Added gasket between carburetor and airbox.
- 13. Nose gear strut extended one inch for additional prop clearance.
- 14. Flap switch boot seal.

1974 Traveler (AA-5) Design Improvements

- 1. Electric clock replaced mechanical spring type.
- 2. Heater duct "Y" adapter changed from fiberglass to aluminum.
- 3. Larger pulleys on control systems to improve cable life.
- 4. Canopy latch shaft changed from aluminum to steel.
- 5. Added stiffener to engine baffle for additional oil cooler support.

- 6. Radio speaker changed to higher power capability (S/N AA5-0380).
- 7. Headliner material changed.
- 8. Exterior placards To improve toughness.
- 9. Increased strength of front seat adjustment arm.
- 10. New carburetor fitting to eliminate fuel seepage.
- 11. Relocated elevator cable turnbuckles to improve accessibility.
- 12. Improved sealing of canopy latch shaft and lock.
- 13. Added drain hole to console at mike jack.
- 14. Added "canopy close" placard to outside rear corner of canopy.
- 15. Increased doubler size under cabin step to increase life.
- 16. Cabin vent box improvements to eliminate leakage.
- 17. Reduced number of fasteners for outer wing panel access covers.
- 18. Improved vacuum system with differential gage.
- 19. Additional fasteners for AA-5 carburetor airbox to increase life.
- 20. Elevator trim tab hinge improvements.
- 21. Added gasket between carburetor and airbox.
- 22. Nose gear strut extended one inch for additional prop clearance.
- 23. Fuel tank access cover improvements thicker covers, new sealant eliminate cover waxing.
- 24. Flap switch boot seal.
